 - a guiet space, in case you need time to pause
 - an area designated for wellbeing and fun activities

THE VENUE

The conference venue is at the University Centre West Anglia, at the College of West Anglia, situated in the beautiful and historic town of King's Lynn. The nearest train station is King's Lynn. We will have use of a lecture theatre and breakout rooms, the Hub area for lunch and networking and the College Novus restaurant for the networking event.
