Equipment Required for Maths Subjects

- Calculator (*not mobile phone*) - a scientific calculator will be required for GCSE Maths (*we recommend Casio FX-83GT Plus*)
 - 30cm ruler (graduated in centimetres and millimetres)
 - Basic geometry set, to include: Protractor; Pair of compasses
 - Pen
 - HB pencil
