Ordering Kit

Stationery Kits, Earphones and Safety Glasses:

Eye protection must be worn in all our Technology workshops. To ensure your eye protection conforms to the relevant safety standard, **we require all students to purchase their safety glasses from the College**. Standard 'wraparound adjustable clear safety glasses' will be suitable for the majority of students. However, for students who normally wear prescription glasses, there is an 'overspec clear safety glasses' option. You will be able to buy these safety glasses from the College shop when you start your course.
